Change of terminology and year levels for Teaching Area units

The Teaching Area or Areas which you were offered on entry to the course will now be referred to as First and Second, rather than Major and Minor Teaching Areas. This is to avoid them being confused with Majors and Minors associated with courses at Curtin.

The Teaching Area units have been divided into two groups, as shown below. For any Teaching Area units that you have not yet completed, it is recommended that you complete Group A Teaching Area Units in Year 1 and Group B Teaching Area Units in Year 2. If you are unable to complete these units in the recommended sequence, you should discuss this with your Course Coordinator prior to enrolling in the unit.
