# **DEMONSTRATING FINANCIAL CAPACITY**



Use this guide to show how you meet the Curtin University Financial Capacity requirement. It is recommended that you read and understand this document before submitting your initial Application and Acceptance of Offer.

#### **Financial Capacity Assessments at Curtin University**

Applicants may be required to demonstrate financial capacity to meet the tuition, living and travel costs associated with studying in Australia. They must also show that they can support any family members accompanying them during their stay in Australia. The following must be provided for assessment:

- 1. A completed Financial Capacity Declaration form; and
- 2. Documentary evidence that satisfies only one of Option (1) or Option (2) described below.

Please note - applicants in some countries may be required to provide additional documents - see the relevant country checklist for further details. Examples of additional required documents include:

- Business cards for branch managers of banks issuing the statements submitted to be used for verification purposes;
- Government issued business and personal income tax returns for the previous 2 3 years, for use in assessing ongoing support for the applicant;
- Evidence of family relationship e.g. birth certificates or family registers.

### Option 1: Showing evidence of sufficient funds to meet 12-months of expenses in Australia

The amount of funds applicants must show evidence for must be calculated by adding the totals for items (i), (ii) and (iii) in the table below:

Applicants must demonstrate that they have access to the funds calculated above by providing evidence of funds from, but not limited to, the following sources:

- 1. Personal Savings Evidence of funds held in deposit accounts (e.g. fixed deposit, savings or current accounts) can be provided, provided that:
  - i. the accounts are personal accounts and **not** corporate or business accounts;
  - ii. the history of the funds in the account can be tracked and explained for a period of no less than 3 months; and
  - iii. Explanations are provided for all large deposits in to the account.

#### Please note:

- iv. Statements which are not clearly legible or are missing relevant information, such as the name of the account holder, bank contact details etc. will not be accepted
- v. Fixed deposits must be scheduled to mature before the applicant is planning to commence their studies.
- 2. Sponsorship or Family Support Family members or relatives eligible to sponsor an applicant are, parents and siblings; siblings-in-law and parents-in-law. The following must be provided:
  - · A signed undertaking from a close relative that includes an explanation of the relationship between the applicant and sponsor(s)
  - · Proof of relationship documents for example, birth certificates or family registers and government photo ID like passports or national identity cards
  - Evidence of Funds held by the sponsor(s) or transferred to the applicant
- 3. Education Loans Education loans from recognised financial institutions, Government bodies, or other acceptable agencies. The following must be provided:
  - Evidence of loan approval which includes relevant information, such as the applicants name, the value of the loan, bank or loan officer contact details, loan term and dates etc.
  - Evidence of the disbursement of the loan to the applicant or directly to Curtin University.

## Option 2: Meeting the minimum annual income requirement

Applicants can also demonstrate their financial capacity by meeting the minimum annual income requirement which is:

- AUD\$87,856 for single applicants; or
- AUD\$102,500 for applicants accompanied by family member(s).

Please note: The income demonstrated must be the personal income of the applicant's spouse or parent(s) only. Parent's income can be a combined amount, for instance AUD\$30,000 from one parent and \$57,856 from the other, where they are sponsoring a single applicant. Spouses acting as a sponsor must not be accompanying the applicant to Australia. The following evidence must be provided:

- Evidence of annual income, in the form of official Government documentation for example, income tax assessments. These documents must have been issued within 12 months of the date it is submitted to Curtin University.
- A signed undertaking from a close relative that includes an explanation of the relationship between the applicant and sponsor(s).
- · Proof of relationship documents for example, birth certificates or family registers and government photo ID like passports or national identity cards.

## All applicants note:

- 1. All official documents submitted will be verified with the source organisation e.g. banks and government authorities.
- 2. Curtin University may request further documents to support applications.
- 3. If additional documents are requested, they must be provided to the University within 7 working days. Where the documents are not provided within this time frame, the application for assessment will be rejected and must be resubmitted.
