Bus routes 100 and 101 connect Curtin with the Canning Bridge train station. Routes 998 and 999 connect Curtin with Oats Street train station.

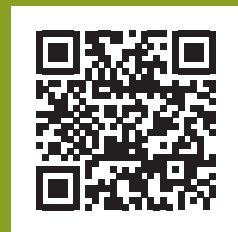
