This program complements the School of Education's Bachelor of Education (BEd) and Master of Teaching (MTeach) courses and is an 'industry-facing' program designed to support pre-service teachers consolidate their professional teaching and leadership capabilities as they prepare to enter the teaching profession.

Note: Students in their third or fourth year can apply for Level 1 or Level 2 of the program if they meet eligibility conditions and have surpassed the minimum unit requirements. Those who haven't completed all first and second-year units are ineligible for Level 2.
