



Are You Interested In Developing Your Confidence And Leadership Skills As You Enter A Teaching Profession?

This program complements the School of Education's Bachelor of Education (BEd) and Master of Teaching (MTeach) courses and is designed to support pre-service teachers build their confidence, personal style, and leadership capabilities.

Note: Students can apply for Level 1 if they meet the below 'Eligibility to apply' conditions and have completed more than the minimum unit requirements. That is, students in their second, third, or fourth year of studies can apply for the Level 1 program, if eligible. Students who have not completed all their first-year units are not eligible for Level 1 of this program.

- Credited and/or passed all first-year core units in their respective course by the end of Semester 2, 2023

Programs are limited to 50 places and will be provided to the first 50 successful applications received of each course. There are no direct costs to selected students for entry into the program.

Program content

The intention of this program is to assist aspirational students to develop a robust teacher identity in terms of their capabilities, commitment, and connection. The program has three components that combine internal and external professional development opportunities: directed reading and online modules, a full-day workshop, and self-determined learning of particular interest and relevance, undertaken through an external agency and/or online provision and/or Curtin School of Education's Professional Learning Hub. This will have been pre-approved by the program coordinator.
