Attend a Student Success activity

5 points : 1 to 1.5 hours

10 points: 1.5 and over

Student Success Kalgoorlie hosts many on campus activities to build on your professional skills and provides pathways to develop yourself beyond the textbook ensuring you are ready for your future job prospects. Please join us at events like our Professional Skills Development Day, Employability week, Careers Tips Tuesdays or join our mentoring programs.

Attend a Library workshop

5 points : 30 to 90 minutes

Library workshops can help you get a jump on all things related to your studies. The Library hosts a variety of academic and study skills workshops to help you study smarter not harder!

Provide the date of your workshop, title, and name of the facilitator.



Attend a counselling or wellbeing workshop

5 points : 1 to 1.5 hours

Counselling and wellbeing have services, resources, and advice to support you during crises and other stressful situations. **Attend a workshop**, and one of the lunch time life skills on a range of topics.

Provide the name and date of the workshop(s) you attended and answer a reflection question.

Review your Career Guides

5 points : 30 to 45 minutes

Explore Career Guides in the **UniHub Resource Library** for information specific to your industry highlighting jobs, employers and professional associations.

Search the Resource Library for your career guide and answer five short questions relating to your industry.

Meet with a New to Curtin student Mentor

5 points : Under 30 minutes

Peer Academic Mentors are current students, ready to provide you with tips and advice to help you settle on campus. They help with academic skills, faculty specific info, navigating Blackboard, OASIS and much more.

Provide the date of your meeting, meeting mode (online or in person), and the name of your N2CKal mentor.

Attend a approved WIL experience

10 points : 1.5 to 2 hours

Broaden your knowledge and skills into a different areas through approved Work Integrated Learning experiences. Keep your eye on the Buzz for approved workshops.

Upload a photo of yourself attending the activity and a screenshot of the logbook letter you receive after completing the workshop.

Complete an online Challenge module

5 points : 45 minutes to 1.5 hours

Develop your skills with the self-paced online modules of **Challenge**. Spanning career guidance, personal development, and cultural topics - there is so much to explore!

Note: Each Challenge pathway has multiple modules. You don't need to complete the whole set to obtain points - just at least one module.

Provide the name and date of the module completed and answer a reflection question.



Review your resume or LinkedIn profile using VMock

5 points : Under 45 minutes

VMock scans your document providing instant, targeted suggestions about your resume.

Aspire, accessed through VMock, will help you optimise your LinkedIn profile. Your student ID and password are all you need to activate your VMock account.

Upload a screenshot of your VMock score and/or Aspire feedback. Upload a second screenshot with your updated score after responding to feedback.



Participate in a Curtin Volunteers! activity

10 points : Over an hour

Curtin Volunteers! provides volunteering and leadership opportunities. Meet new people, build your employability skills, explore WA, and give back. There's something for everyone!

Upload a screenshot of the dashboard on your Volunteer Portal which shows your name, shifts and hours.

Attend a Student Guild Club event

5 points : 1 hour

The **Student Guild Clubs** offer a variety of events that will help you connect with other likeminded students and have some fun.

Upload a selfie with a club rep at the event and provide the name of the club representative in the selfie next to you. Name the event where you attended and answer a reflection question.

Support a Student Guild or Club Committee Event

5 points : Over an hour

Reps sit on various committees to ensure that your voice is heard. See what **Student Guild committees** and **Student Guild Club committees** you could be a part of.

Upload a photo of yourself supporting a Guild Club activity with a photo of you completing a supporting task. E.g. cooking at the BBQ or assisting with event set-up or pack down.

Rewards

Join First Year Rewards and earn points that can be redeemed for instant rewards like gift vouchers and merch!
