

Submission Requirements for Graduation

Bachelor of Technology

Applicable to students graduating from **Semester 1, 2019** onward.

1. Exposure to Professional Engineering Practice (EPEP) Logbook (white)

Digital copies of the logbook are available for download on the **Science and Engineering Fieldwork and Placement Portal** at

https://www.curtin.edu.au/students/experience/industry/science-engineering/portal/. One entry per experience and all entries must be confirmed with an official letter, certificate or other acceptable form of evidence as stipulated by the requirements in your logbook. See Letter from employer below for evidence requirements. All students must accumulate at least 320 weighted hours of EPEP to graduate.

2. Reflective report

a. ENG, TECH, GENE and PRI experiences

The required length of the reflective report will depend on the EPEP category and time engaged in your experience. Please refer to the EPEP Logbook reflective report guide on the Science and Engineering Fieldwork and Placement Portal (link above).

b. GEN, PRES and PROF experiences

A 200-word short-form reflection is required for each experience. Students must use the standard **short-form reflection template** provided on the **Science and Engineering Fieldwork and Placement Portal** (link above).

PRES category placement requirement: To graduate, you must have completed 16 weighted hours of PRES. This component is included in the total 320 hours requirement and typically corresponds to 4 technical presentations/sessions. Please refer to the category details in your white logbook for more information.

3. Letter from employer

The letter must include the following:

- Company letterhead with organisation address and contact details.
- **Duration of employment** date period and total hours must be included.
- **Confirmation** that your reflective report has been read and is accurate.
- **Signature** from your supervisor (with contact number and position title) / **company stamp.**

To claim PRI experience, the same letter should be provided. Please contact your school logbook support team if this is not feasible.

4. Submission standards (all students)

All students submitting an EPEP Logbook must review the **Submission standards (all students)** document on the **Science and Engineering Fieldwork and Placement Portal** (link above) to ensure submissions are valid and complete.

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
