

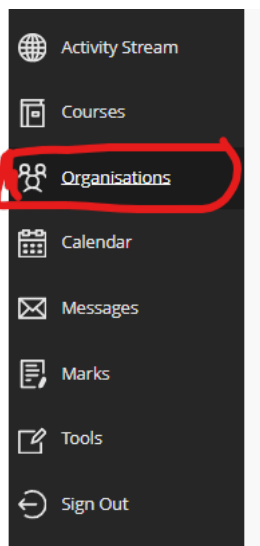
Research Integrity and HDR Essentials An 'Organisation' on Blackboard

Instructions on how to self-enrol and complete this training

How to self-enrol in 'Research Integrity and HDR Essentials'

You can self-enrol into the training called Research Integrity and HDR Essentials, an organisation on Blackboard, Curtin's Learning Management System for students. Please read the attached instructions. Note - when trying to self-enrol, follow these steps:

1. Log into Student OASIS <https://oasis.curtin.edu.au/Auth/LogOn>
Click on the link to Blackboard. Your Blackboard home page will load.
2. Navigate to the 'Organisations' in the left-hand Menu



3. On the top right-hand side of screen, select 'Organisation Catalogue'.
4. Search for 'Research Integrity and HDR Essentials', select 'Go'
5. hover over the organisation heading (Research_int_HDR_org), a down arrow should pop up at end of the heading
6. click on the down arrow
7. click on 'enrol'.
8. Under column 'Organisation ID", hover over the 'Research_int_HDR_org to display the downward arrow, and then select Enrol.

- login to OASIS,
- go to the My Studies tab in [OASIS](#), then click the Blackboard button.
- open Blackboard – this will open the 'Home' screen (includes comprehensive about Blackboard including online tools and functionality.)
- In the left-hand menu click on the 'Organisations' heading (as per pic below).
- On the right-hand side of the screen, locate and click on the heading *Research Integrity and HDR Essentials*

I've logged into the unit, what do I do now?

The unit Menu (on the left-hand-side) displays the contents for the course:

- **Announcements** - information about completion of the unit
- **Contacts**
- **Unit Materials** – (includes 13 short courses, with a Quiz for each course.
- **My Grades** - shows the Pass/Fail result once a user has submitted the quiz. A Pass grade is awarded where a minimum of 80% of questions are answered correctly
- **Originality Checking** – contains links to Turnitin for uploading documents
- **Turnitin How-to videos**
- **Studiosity** link (for online research writing help)

What do the module quizzes involve?

- Each quiz contains 10 multiple-choice questions.
- You must achieve 80% to pass each individual quiz (8/10).
- Each quiz can be saved and resumed later
- Each quiz allows multiple attempts until a pass is achieved for that quiz
- **My Grades** (in the left-hand menu) - the result for the quiz will show as a score out of 10. You must score a minimum of 8/10 (80%) to pass a quiz

- When you have passed all 13 quizzes, your Final Grade will say 'Pass'.
- To view/print your Pass result, click on 'My Grades' and select **all**. If you are submitting an ethics application, you will need to attach a copy of the screen shot.

How to print your Pass result

To view/print your own screenshot, please follow these instructions.

- From your Blackboard home page, in the left-hand menu, select 'Marks'
- Then select Research Integrity and HDR Essentials.
- Your result will be on the top line and will say Pass or Fail.
- Take a screen shot of your pass result, ensure the following information is included:
 1. The name of the training appears on the right-hand side of the screen "Research Integrity and HDR Essentials",
 2. 'Pass'
 3. Your name - which appears in the top left-hand corner of your Blackboard homepage,
