

***Your Campus, Your Commute, Your Way* competition – Entry Terms and Conditions**

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for this competition form part of the conditions of entry.
2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
4. The competition is being run by Curtin University, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 ("Curtin University").
5. The competition commences at 12:00pm Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on 26 February 2025.
6. The closing time for entering the competition is 3pm AWST on 26 February 2025.
7. Entry to the competition is limited to current Curtin University students with an active enrolment.
8. To enter the competition, the entrant must:
 - (a) Be a current Curtin University student.
 - (b) Have completed full time enrolment for the whole year of 2025 into their respective study periods e.g. semesters, trimesters etc.
 - (c) Have completed class registration for all enrolled internal units for all study periods in the first half of 2025.
 - (d) Answer the ten (10) provided questions fully and correctly and submit these questions through the designated online entry found here: <https://students.connect.curtin.edu.au/scavengerhunt> using their student credentials.
 - (e) Submit their playing card to a Curtin Mentor located in The Arcade, Building 103.101 Curtin Perth campus before 3pm AWST on the day of the event.
 - (f) Have registered your vehicle with [CellOPark](#) (if choosing parking paid for a semester prize)
9. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
10. Entrants may only enter the competition one time, once they have completed the requirements listed above.
11. Staff employed by Curtin University and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter the competition.
12. There will be three (3) main prize options available, with the winner selecting one (1) prize from: a bicycle and helmet to the value of \$500; a Transperth SmartRider card with \$300 pre-loaded credit or; parking paid for a semester (26 February – 13 June) in Green and Yellow parking zones. Winner of the parking prize will need to provide their name, car make and registration for one registered vehicle to be eligible. There will also be ten additional supplementary prizes including; five Transperth SmartRider cards with \$50 pre-loaded credit and five \$50 Curtin Guild vouchers.
13. There will be one (1) draw at 9:30am Australian Western Standard Time on Wednesday 5 March, 2025 at Curtin University, Building 101. The draw will be by random number generator from all eligible entries received, with the first winner drawn able to choose one of the three main prizes. Ten subsequent winners be drawn after this and will receive one of the ten (10) supplementary prizes.
14. All prize winners will be contacted within seven (7) days of the draw via their Curtin student preferred mobile number to select their prize, followed by a confirmation email sent to their Curtin student email account.

15. If the prize winner does not respond to claim the prize within twenty-four hours (24) of the draw, a re-draw will be conducted within forty eight hours (48) of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method. Redraws will continue in the same manner until all prizes have been claimed by prize winners.
16. If the prize winner is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to the winner's parent or legal guardian.
17. The prizes may be collected in person (if applicable) by the prize winner or parent/legal guardians. Details of the collection point and time will be provided by email to the winners Curtin student email account.
18. If a prize winner who has been contacted and been made aware of their prize winning, and has agreed to collect the prize or for which collection is the only method for receiving the prize, does not collect the prize within twenty-one (21) days of this contact, a re-draw will be conducted within thirty (30) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method.
19. The prize winner, or if under the age of 18 years their parent or legal guardian, may be required to provide evidence of their identity (such as Student ID or current passport) when receiving the prize.
20. The prize winner will be responsible for all costs associated with collecting and using the prize.
21. By entering the competition the entrant agrees that they are over the age of 18 years, or if under the age of 18 years, have their parent's or legal guardian's consent to enter the competition.
22. The prize is not redeemable for cash or an alternative prize.
23. The prize is not transferrable.

By entering the competition, entrants grant Curtin University permission to use their full name on its website and applicable social media page for up to six months from the date of the draw.
