

Acuity Insights Assessments – Comprehensive Admissions Assessments

All applicants applying to the Bachelor of Medicine, Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS), at Curtin University are required to complete Casper for the 2024/2025 admissions cycle.

Casper is a standardised, multi-part online assessment that measures different competencies and attributes that we believe are important for successful students and graduates of our program. Casper will complement the other tools that we use for applicant review and evaluation. In implementing Casper, we are trying to further enhance fairness and objectivity in our selection process.

- **Casper:** 90-110 minute online, open-response situational judgment test

How to complete Casper:

In order to take Casper, you will be responsible for securing access to a laptop or desktop computer with webcam and audio capabilities and a reliable internet connection with an internet speed of at least 1.5 Mbps and upload speed of at least 2 Mbps. You will require the following for both account creation and completing Casper:

- Government-issued photo ID (English) for account validation
 - Valid email address (the same one you will use to submit your application)
 - Desktop or laptop computer
 - Working webcam
 - Working microphone
 - Reliable high-speed internet connection
1. Please go to www.acuityinsights.app to sign up for Casper for (School leavers and Course Switchers) CSP - 10411- AUS Undergraduate Health Sciences. Postgraduate students will sign up for CSP-20411 - AUS Postgraduate Health Sciences. Select your specific country, and register using your TISC ID for Domestic Applicants, Curtin Application ID for International Applicants and a piece of government-issued photo ID. This number will need two zeros in front of it to make a ten digit ID number.
 2. Select a Casper test date. You will be provided with a limited number of testing dates and times, which have been pre-arranged/approved by your program(s) in accordance with their admissions timelines. Please note that these are the only testing dates available for your Casper test based on your program selection(s). There will be no additional tests scheduled. Please use an email address that

you check regularly and that you have used for your application; there may be updates to the test schedule.

- Important: To account for identity verification and payment processing timelines, ensure that you register for your test at least 3 days before your preferred test date and time. Last-minute bookings are not recommended.
- 1. Ensure you have selected Curtin University for distribution before the posted distribution deadline. Likely, there will be no additional tests scheduled, but the most up-to-date information can be found by browsing the [Test Dates and Times](#) on [acuityinsights.app](#).
