



In addition to satisfying Curtin University minimum English standard requirements for nursing and midwifery courses, all applicants must also demonstrate English language proficiency as specified in the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia's (NMBA) English language skills registration standard.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

If you are applying for admission you must demonstrate your English language competency in one of the following:

1. English is your primary language and by course commencement you have attended and satisfactorily completed at least six years of primary and secondary education taught and assessed solely in English in Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Republic of Ireland, South Africa, United Kingdom or United States of America, including at least two years between years 7 and 12.
OR
2. You have achieved the required minimum scores of IELTS 7.0/7.0 (or equivalent test score as stated here: [English competency equivalents charts](#)) and the test was undertaken within two years of the course commencement date.
