

CHECK IF YOU'RE ELIGIBLE FOR SEMESTER OR YEAR-LONG EXCHANGE

Consider going on exchange early in your degree as this generally provides the most flexibility and more opportunities.



To go on semester exchange, undergraduate students must be at least in their first semester of the second year of their course.

Postgraduate students must be in at least the second semester of their course, but this can be reviewed if you have completed a Curtin undergraduate degree. This can also be negotiated if you wish to study at another Curtin Campus.

To apply for a semester or year-long exchange program you must be able to meet the following requirements upon assessment of your application:

- be admitted in an undergraduate coursework degree or be admitted into a postgraduate degree that has a minimum 300 credits at a Curtin campus (you can apply while on an approved Leave of Absence, but must be enrolled prior to departure)
- have a course weighted average (CWA) of 60 or above in your current course of study (some partner universities may require a higher CWA)
- have an academic status of 'Good Standing' with no academic misconduct, prior to departure
- be able to maintain full-time enrolment and attendance at the partner university
- have completed an approved Study Plan Proposal form.

If you don't meet the eligibility requirements, you may have your application assessed on a case-by-case basis, based on circumstance and merit. Additional documentation, including an Academic Reference may be requested to support your application.

Information for international students

While you are participating in the semester exchange program you are required to continue to meet your Australian student visa conditions.

Ineligible students

The following students are not eligible to apply for the semester exchange program:

- Australia Award Students (AAS)
- Open University Australia enrolled students (OUA)
- Students admitted in non-degree programs
- Students admitted in a Curtin graduate certificate, graduate diploma or postgraduate course of 200 credits or less (unless applying to study at another Curtin campus).

Sponsored students must seek approval from Go Global prior to applying for exchange.
